



- "Noah's House provides a safe, inclusive space that contributes to positive mental health support in a non-clinical setting."



About Noah's House

"We are a mental health charity in Windsor, Ontario. Noah's House was established in 2018 after **Noah Butcher-Hagell** lost his battle with mental illness. Noah's House is working to fill the gap on mental health support in a non-clinical setting for individuals ages 11-25. In Jan 2020, after over a year of searching, we opened our first location. In May 2020, we expanded into the space next door. This would become the home of the Noah's House Youth Centre."

Noah's House Short and Long-Term Goals

- Noah's House has some notable goals for the future that they plan to eventually execute once they are able to financially. One of their goals is to **Expand** the services and programs they offer to be able to target and interest all youth in the community.
- There are multiple programs Noah's House wishes to run in the future that they don't have the capacity to run at the moment. For example, if and when Noah's House is able to **build a basketball court**, they desire to possibly organize a few **basketball tournaments** for the youth in society.



How does Noah's House Help others in the Community?

- ❑ Noah's House allows youth in the community to break free from the chains of mental illness. It **offers support** to these citizens in the community in order to be able to bridge that gap on mental health supports, so that youth has a place to go, say, in between school, or therapy appointments.
- ❑ Since mental health is a significant issue in today's society, Noah's House allows youth in the community to not feel bogged down, and feel like their life is consumed by a certain diagnosis.
- ❑ Noah's House is fully **inclusive**, and is founded upon the goals of having a youth centre, where **no youth is turned away**; it is fully inclusive to all youth in the local community, and ultimately helps the youth understand, protect, and sustain their mental health.

Noah's House: In Person Social Services

Noah's house is open for youth's in the local community Monday through Friday, from **9AM** until **5PM**. Noah's house ultimately offers care for young adults in two different domains: the **clinical side**, and the **non-clinical side**. The clinical side is where you can choose to seek free counselling offered inside the centre. The non-clinical side offers peer-to-peer support, where teenagers and young adults can talk to volunteers associated with Noah's house that are of a similar age, essentially allowing more in-depth support due to the fact that they may be able to relate to what these citizens are possibly experiencing.

- ▶ “Bro Code is for anyone who is male-identifying. Each week will explore topics related to communication, boundaries, relational aggression, and so much more to motivate and inspire young men to get in touch with themselves, find their self-worth, and discover their passions. (Age 13-17)”

Self Love Club:

- ▶ “Self-Love Club will explore topics related to self-love, boundaries, relational aggression, and so much more to motivate and inspire young women to get in touch with themselves, find their self-worth, and discover their passions. (Ages 13-17)”

- “Crafting can help with the symptoms of anxiety, depression, and loneliness, according to research. So join us where each week we do a new craft and focus on positive mental health activities.”

How would Noah's House use \$5000?

During an extensive interview with a support member at Noah's House, we came to the conclusion that **\$5000 dollars** could go a long way at Noah's House. When visiting the establishment we discovered that they had a generous amount of toys and games for youth there. An abundance of indoor board games, electronics, and stationary toys like foosball tables. However, the representative that we spoke with expressed an interest and need for a cement pad at the facility to be poured for the use of a basketball court. A healthy way to get the youth outdoors when the weather permits to promote a healthy and interactive environment for the attending youth.
